

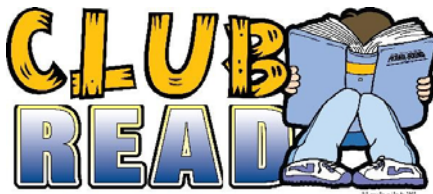

Club Read: Books To Movies

This summer, encourage library visits and motivate book selection for summer reading with an imaginary movie ticket! There are many ways to entice and inspire summer reading in conjunction with newly released/popular movies. Public school and library summer reading programs have adopted "matinee time" strategies to attract patrons. Many have seen a great community response, with patrons arriving to watch a movie, then perusing the stacks for books to read.



Some libraries make sure they have enough of the book version of the movie available to check out from the library system on the day of the matinee. Others may choose a "read the book, then see the movie" program with guided discussion afterward.

Kids can also create their own "Books to Movies" reading club simply by going to the local video store and renting a desired title-then read the book and compare the two!

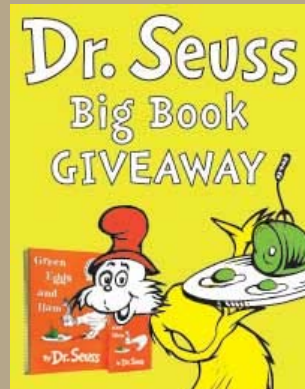
