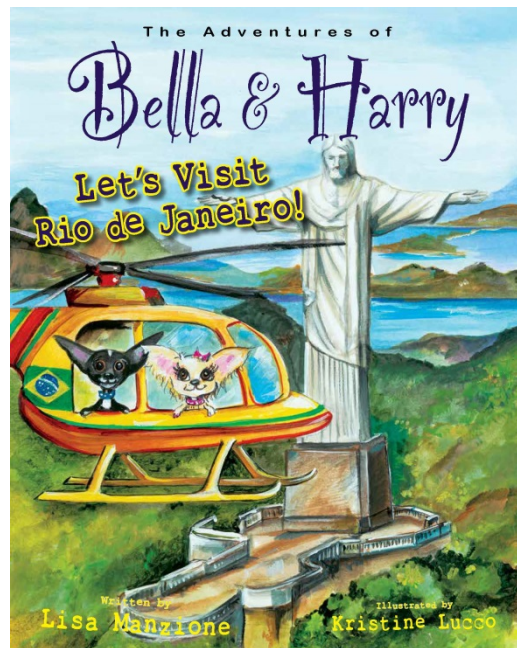


# The Adventures of Bella & Harry:

### **Activities:**

- ~ Have a cultural day and try a variety of Brazilian food.
- ~ Create a journal pretending the student is visiting Rio de Janeiro. Have them document what they see and do.

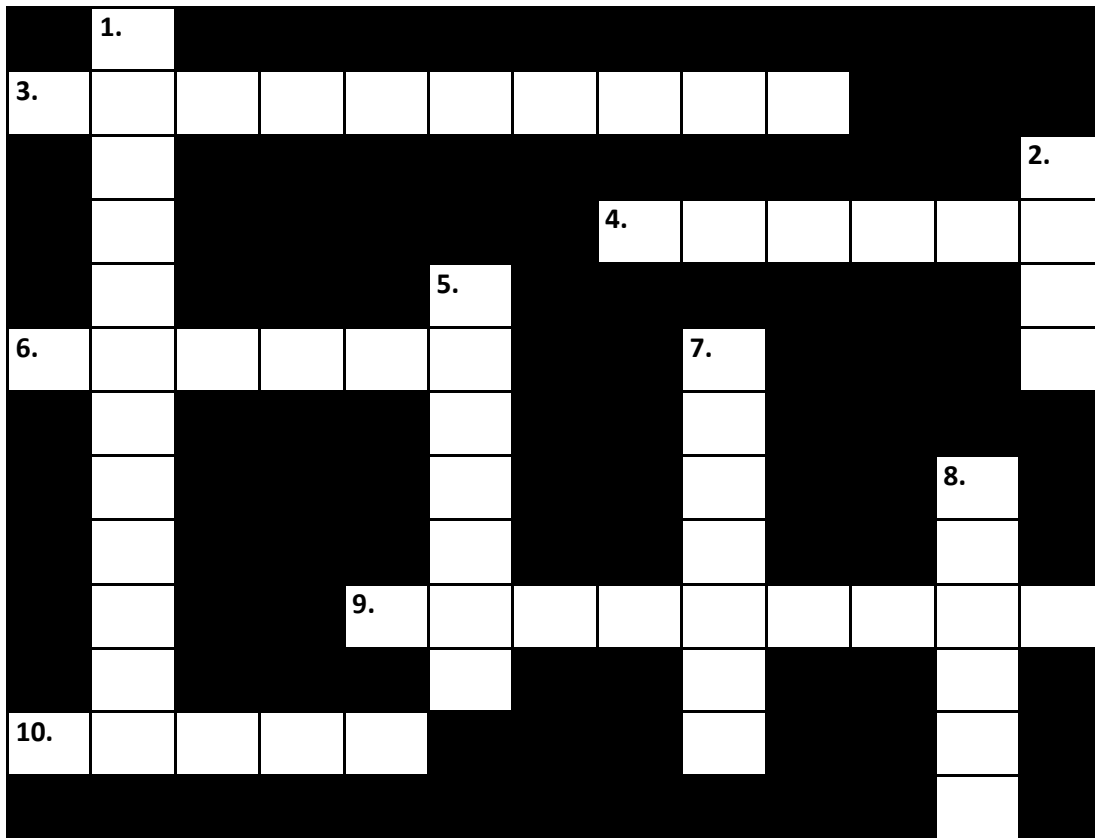

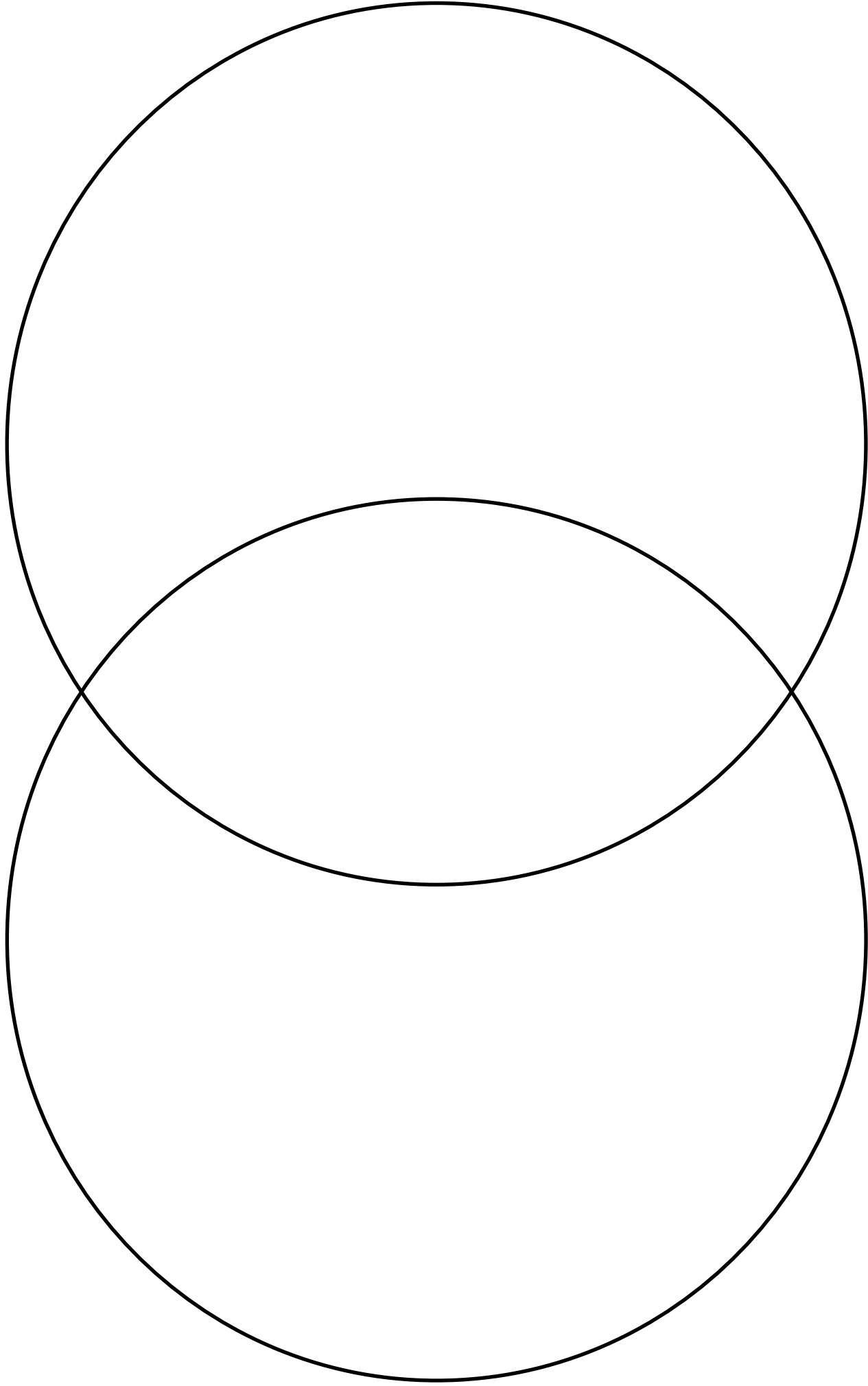

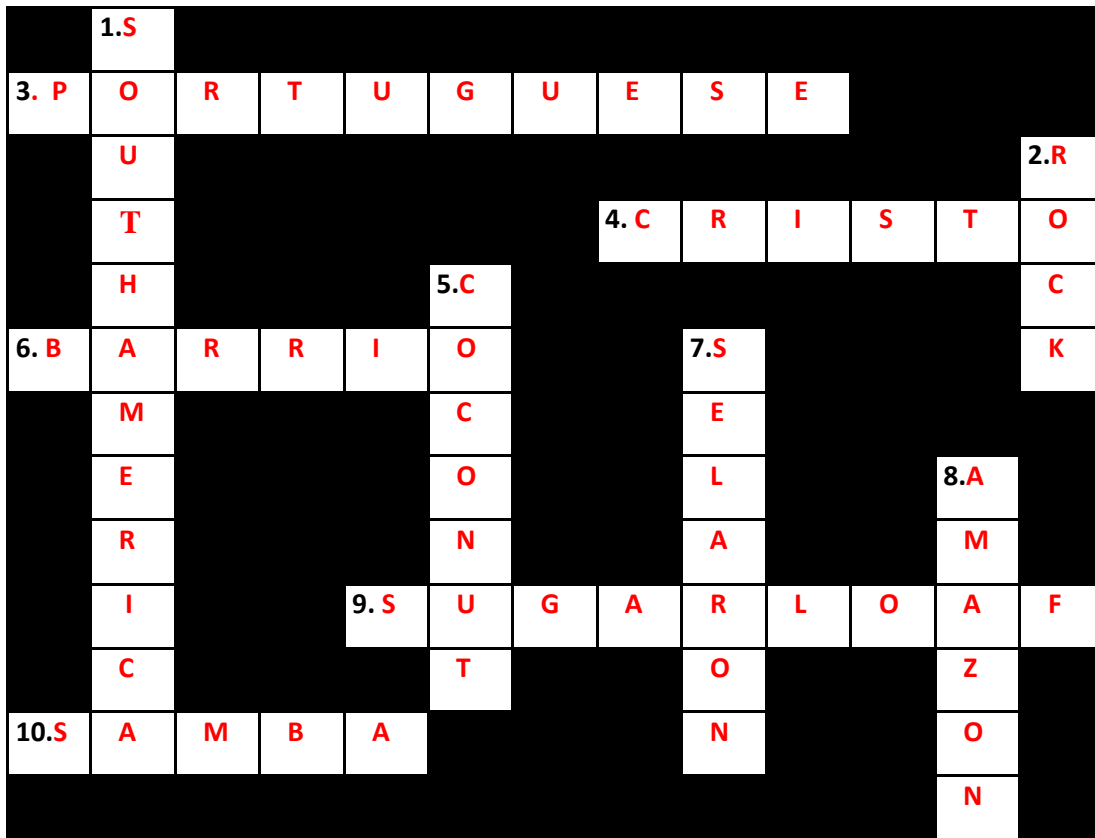
